**Resolution of 13 issues pertaining to industry, energy, road transport, national highways and railways projects of union government should be ensured within 15 days: Chief Secretary**

**Officials of National Highways Authority of India should commence construction within seven days after obtaining possession of land: Deepak Singhal**

**Farmers will have to be benefitted for acquired land with compensation under new Land Acquisition Act: Chief Secretary**

**10<sup>th</sup> meeting of Project Monitoring Group of Cabinet Committee on Investment held with Additional Secretary of PMO under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary**

**Lucknow | July 29, 2016**

Chief Secretary of Uttar Pradesh, Shri Deepak Singhal has directed for resolution of 13 issues pertaining to industry, energy, road transport, national highways and railways projects of union government within 15 days. He asked the officials of National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) to ensure commencement of construction within seven days after obtaining possession of acquired land. He also directed to compensate the farmers, whose lands had been acquired through mutual agreement, according to new Land Acquisition Act.

Chief Secretary was presiding over the 10<sup>th</sup> meeting of Project Monitoring Group of Cabinet Committee on Investment held with Additional Secretary of Prime Minister's Office, Shri Arun Goel. Praising the officials of State government, he said that timely resolution of issues had ensured smooth implementation of projects. He told that issues relating to Western Dedicated Freight Corridor and Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor, under construction Tanda thermal power plant in district Ambedkar Nagar, Mahan thermal power plant, National Highway (NH) – 74 from Bareilly to Sitarganj section, Delhi – Agra stretch of National Highway – 2, Eastern Peripheral Expressway were actively resolved by the officials concerned.

Shri Singhal directed for speedy resolution of issues pertaining to Etawah – Chakeri section of NH, Rae Bareli – Tanda section of NH 232, Muzaffarnagar – Haridwar section of NH 58, Varanasi – Gorakhpur section of NH 29 and four-lane widening of Mau – Gorakhpur roads. He said that senior officers should ensure regular monitor of these projects to ensure quality and standard.

Meeting was attended by Principal Secretary, Planning – Shri Arun Kumar Sinha, Principal Secretary, PWD – Smt. Aradhana Shukla, Principal Secretary, Medical and Health – Shri Arvind Kumar, Principal Secretary, Energy – Shri Sanjay Agarwal along with other officials.
