

Allotment of unutilised industrial plots to be cancelled

Allotment of industrial plots which have not been utilized by establishing industrial units within the stipulated time period will be cancelled after serving due notice. These plots will be allotted to such investors who are really desirous of setting up industrial units.

Principal Secretary, Infrastructure & Industrial Development Department, Dr Surya Pratap Singh said, “A survey will be conducted to identify such industrial plots in industrial development authorities to check if the land use allowed in the application for allotment of plots is being adhered to or not.”

“If the industrial unit has not been set up according to the land use allowed or the land is being used in violation of rules and regulations or the plot is lying unutilized after expiry of stipulated time duration allowed to set up an industrial unit, then the entrepreneur will be served the due notice and allotment will be cancelled, so that the genuinely desirous investors are provided the industrial plots,” he added.
